Desert rose Figurative painter Princess Hayfa Abdullah, daughter of Abdullah bin Abdulaziz Al Saud, the late king of Saudi Arabia, is showcasing her first solo show in the United States. Exhibited at Stellan Holm Gallery, the new series of 25 paintings focuses on surrealist representations of the Arabic culture in which Abdullah was raised, capturing the subjects through a perspective that is both vibrant and rebellious. "I come from a land of sand and sun, a kingdom filled with traditions as old as time. For me, I speak through my paintbrush. And rather than painting the world I am 'supposed to see', I reach into the depths of my imagination and I paint what my soul wants", explains the Jeddah-based artist.
